will be used to meet the requirements of Chapter 4101 Florida Residential Code 2017, 6<sup>th</sup> Edition.

\_\_\_\_\_ The pool will be isolated from access to the home by a safety barrier that meets the pool barrier requirements of Florida Residential Code R4101.17.

\_\_\_\_\_ The Pool will be equipped with an approved safety pool cover that complies with ASTM F1346-91 (Standard Performance Specifications for Safety Covers for Swimming Pools, Spas, and Hot Tubs).

\_\_\_\_\_ All doors and windows providing direct access from the home to the pool will be equipped with an exit alarm that has minimum sound pressure rating of 85 decibels at 10 feet and is either hard-wired or of the plug in type conforming to the Florida Residential Code R4101.17.1.9.

\_\_\_\_\_ All doors providing direct access from the home to the pool will be equipped with self-closing, self-latching devices with release mechanisms placed no lower than 54" above the threshold conforming to the Florida Residential Code R4101.17.1.9.

I understand that not having one of the above installed at the time of final inspection, or when the pool is completed for contract purposes, will constitute a violation of the Florida Building Code R4101.
