

RESOLUTION NO. 15-83

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF TREASURE ISLAND AWARDING A CONTRACT TO BAYSHORE CONSTRUCTION, INC. FOR 84th AVE & 123rd AVE DOCK REPLACEMENT AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Treasure Island's Department of Public Works (DPW) has determined that there is a need for certain improvements to the City's Boat Docks at 84th Ave and 123rd Ave; and

WHEREAS, the City of Treasure Islands DPW through the resources of its engineer of record completed a design and bid specification and solicited competitive bids from qualified contractors for the 84th Ave and 123rd Ave Dock Replacements; and

WHEREAS, the City of Treasure Island received two (2) competitive proposals for the work and the City's engineer of record and evaluated those bids on the basis of their responsiveness to the bid request identifying a successful bidder; and

WHEREAS, the City of Treasure Island's engineer of record has identified and recommended that Bayshore Construction, Inc. as the lowest responsive responsible bidder based on the evaluated price of \$57,330.00; and

WHEREAS, funding in the amount of \$38,480.00 is available in account 123-5300-63362 and authorize a Supplemental Budget Appropriation from the LOISS Fund unappropriated fund balance in the amount of \$24,583.00 for the 84th Ave and 123rd Ave Dock Replacements; and

WHEREAS, The City of Treasure Island Commission, after due consideration, has determined that the award of said contract is in the best interest of the City of Treasure Island.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF TREASURE ISLAND DOES RESOLVE THAT:

Section 1. The City Commission approves the award of a contract to Bayshore Construction Inc., in the amount of \$57,330.00 for the 84th Ave and 123rd Ave Dock Replacements.

Section 2. The City Commission authorizes the City Manager to approve change orders in the total amount of \$5,733.00 for unforeseen changes and conditions as approved by the City's Engineer of Record AED. The City Commission shall be given notification of all change orders approved by the City Manager.

Section 3. The City Commission approves the appropriation of funds in the amount of \$24,583.00 from the LOISS Fund unappropriated fund balance to provide the balance of the funds needed for these two projects.

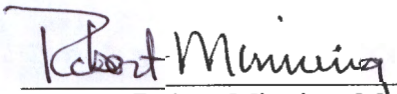
Section 4. This resolution is effective immediately upon adoption.

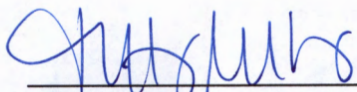
