

RESOLUTION NO. 17-117

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF TREASURE ISLAND APPROVING THE CONTRACT AWARD TO G.A. NICHOLS COMPANY IN THE AMOUNT OF \$724,855 FOR THE CENTRAL BEACH TRAIL RECONSTRUCTION PROJECT AND ASSOCIATED BUDGET ADMENDMENT APPROPRIATING FUNDS FROM THE UNDESIGNATED FUND BALANCE WITHIN THE GENERAL FUND IN THE AMOUNT OF \$724,855; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City of Treasure Island requested bids from qualified contractors for the Central Beach Trail Reconstruction project; and

WHEREAS, three (3) qualified contractors submitted bids on October 6, 2017; and

WHEREAS, the lowest and responsive bid was submitted by the G.A. Nichols Company in the amount of \$724,855.; and

WHEREAS, a budget amendment is required to fund this work by appropriating undesignated fund balance within the General Fund in the amount of \$724,855 to the Municipal Services Program; and

WHEREAS, the City of Treasure Island Commission, after due consideration, has determined that execution of said agreement, is in the best interest of the City of Treasure Island.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF TREASURE ISLAND DOES RESOLVE THAT:

Section 1. The City Manager is authorized to execute the Contract with G.A. Nichols Company in the amount of \$644,855 plus an \$80,000 contingency for the Central Beach Trail Reconstruction and authorize the budget amendment to appropriate funding of \$724,855 from the Undesignated General Fund Balance to the Municipal Services Fund 001-5410-63000 Improvements other than Buildings account.

Section 2. This Resolution is effective immediately upon adoption.




