

RESOLUTION NO. 17-121

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF TREASURE ISLAND APPROVING THE PURCHASE OF A REPLACEMENT VACTOR TRUCK FROM GS EQUIPMENT THROUGH THE FLORIDA SHERIFFS ASSOCIATION CONTRACT FSA17-VEH15.0 IN THE AMOUNT OF \$361,281 AND ASSOCIATED BUDGET AMENDMENT WITHIN THE STORMWATER FUND; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City of Treasure Island needs to replace the City's Vactor Truck used in both the Wastewater and Stormwater operations (vehicle #844) due to the age and the operating condition of the truck; and

WHEREAS, the cost of to purchase a new 2018 VacAll AJV1215, 12 yard debris tank with a 1500 gallon fresh water tank mounted on a Mack Chassis as outlined on the GS Equipment, Inc bid is \$361,281, net of trade-in of the current vactor truck ; and

WHEREAS, the purchase of a replacement vactor truck is included in the FY 2017 and carried forward into the FY 2018 budget within the Wastewater Fund; and

WHEREAS, half of the funding for the replacement vactor truck is to be provided by the Stormwater Fund, of which the funds were appropriated in the FY 2017 budget and were intended to be carried forward into the FY 2018 budget, however were inadvertently not carried forward into the FY 2018 Budget; and

WHEREAS, an associated budget amendment to appropriate \$225,000 within the Stormwater Fund balance is needed; and

WHEREAS, the City of Treasure Island Commission, after due consideration, has determined that to appropriate said funds for the purchase of a replacement vactor truck, is in the best interest of the City of Treasure Island.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF TREASURE ISLAND DOES RESOLVE THAT:

Section 1. The Department of Public Works is authorized to purchase a Vactor Truck for \$361,281 to replace the current truck from GS Equipment through the FSA Contract FSA17-Veh15.0.

Section 2. Half of the funding for this purchase is in the FY 2018 Budget within the Wastewater Fund. The other half of the funding will be available through approval of a budget amendment in the amount of \$225,000 to the account 450-5380-64200 within the Stormwater Fund.

Section 3. This Resolution is effective immediately upon adoption.

The foregoing Resolution was offered during Regular Session of the City Commission of the City of Treasure Island, Florida, sitting on the 17th day of October, 2017 by Commissioner Lunn who moved its adoption; was seconded by Commissioner Toth and upon roll call, the vote was:
