

RESOLUTION NO. 15-120

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF TREASURE ISLAND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION HIGHWAY LANDSCAPE REIMBURSEMENT MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT CONTRACT; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City of Treasure Island submitted a Letter of Interest seeking funding for landscaping on Gulf Boulevard; and

WHEREAS, the City of Treasure Island was selected for funding of this Landscape Project on Gulf Boulevard in the amount of \$50,000 by the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT); and

WHEREAS, the City is required to enter into a maintenance agreement with the FDOT in the form of a Highway Landscape Reimbursement Memorandum of Agreement which shall govern the required maintenance of the installed landscape project; and

WHEREAS, the City will be reimbursed up to \$50,000 for all eligible expenditures for the professional design, inspection, and enforcement of the material and installation standards; and the purchase, installation, and establishment of plant material; and

WHEREAS, the City of Treasure Island is in agreement to maintain the landscaping for a period of ten (10) years.

WHEREAS, A supplemental budget adjustment in the amount of \$50,000 is required to provide sufficient funds within the Municipal Services program budget in account 001-5410-4690 until reimbursement.

WHEREAS, The City of Treasure Island Commission, after due consideration, has determined that the execution of this agreement is in the best interest of the City of Treasure Island.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF TREASURE ISLAND DOES RESOLVE THAT:

Section 1. The City Manager is hereby authorized to execute this Highway Landscape Reimbursement Memorandum of Agreement Contract.

Section 2. A supplemental budget appropriation in the amount of \$50,000 approved from the unassigned fund balance of the General Fund to the Municipal Services program budget in account 001-5410-4690. The General Fund will be reimbursed by the FDOT grant.

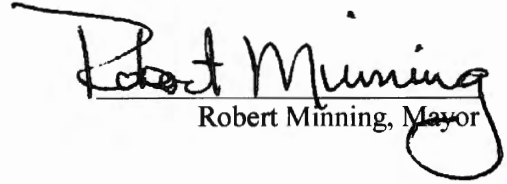
Section 3. This resolution is effective immediately upon adoption.

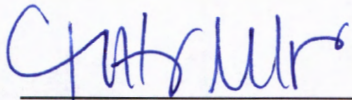
