

RESOLUTION NO. 16-41

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF TREASURE ISLAND APPROVING THE PURCHASE OF A REPLACEMENT FOR PICKUP TRUCK VEHICLE NO. 203; APPROPRIATING FUNDS FROM THE GENERAL FUND UNASSIGNED FUND BALANCE IN THE AMOUNT OF \$34,528.00; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City of Treasure Island Department of Public Works requests authorization to replace Vehicle #203, a two-wheel drive pickup truck due to the unsafe condition of the vehicle caused by rusting of the vehicle's frame and supports: and

WHEREAS, staff is requesting authorization to purchase a 2016 Silverado 25000 HD 4x4 Crew Cab Pickup Truck from the Florida Sheriffs Association cooperative purchasing contract through Alan Jay Fleet Sales in the amount of \$30,178 plus ancillary equipment including an arrow board, power lift gate, bed liner, strobe lights, and undercoating in the amount of \$4,350.00 for the total cost of \$34,528.00 to replace Vehicle 203; and

WHEREAS, the replacement of this vehicle was not budgeted, therefore, funding in the amount of \$34,528.00 shall be appropriated from the Unassigned General Fund Balance; and

WHEREAS, the City of Treasure Island Commission, after due consideration, has determined that it is in the best interest to appropriate said funds for the purchase of the truck,

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF TREASURE ISLAND DOES RESOLVE THAT:

Section 1. Staff is authorized to purchase a 2016 Silverado 25000 HD 4x4 Crew Cab Pickup Truck from the Florida Sheriffs Association cooperative purchasing contract through Alan Jay Fleet Sales in the amount of \$30,178 plus ancillary equipment including an arrow board, power lift gate, bed liner, strobe lights, and undercoating in the amount of \$4,350.00 for the total cost of \$34,528.00 to replace vehicle 203. Staff is authorized to dispose of Vehicle 203 through sale, trade, auction or sealed bid.

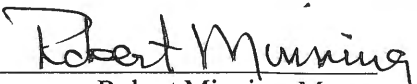
Section 2. This resolution is effective immediately upon adoption.
