

RESOLUTION NO. 16-92

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF TREASURE ISLAND AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF A UTILITY TERRAIN VEHICLE FOR THE TREASURE ISLAND POLICE DEPARTMENT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$9,957.10; AND APPROVING A BUDGET AMENDMENT FOR THE PURCHASE TO APPROPRIATE A \$4,000.00 CONTRIBUTION FROM THE TREASURE ISLAND POLICE ASSOCIATION, \$1,000.00 DONATION FROM THE AMERICAN LEGION POST #158 AND \$4,957.10 FROM THE POLICE CONTRABAND FORFEITURE ACCOUNT TO FUND THE PURCHASE.

WHEREAS, the Treasure Island Police Department's assets include a 2002 Bombardier ATV and a 2003 Gladiator Box Trailer which are in need of replacement; and

WHEREAS, the cost to purchase a Utility Terrain Vehicle (UTV) from St. Pete Powersports is \$9,178.50 using government General Services Administration (GSA) contract pricing; and

WHEREAS, the net cost to purchase the UTV with trade-in allowance and discounts is \$7,301.50; and

WHEREAS, additional costs to outfit the new UTV with emergency equipment and lights is \$2,655.60 for a total cost of \$9,957.10; and

WHEREAS, a budget amendment to accept and appropriate the \$4,000 contribution from the Treasure Island Police Association, the \$1,000 donation from American Legion Post #158, and \$4,957.10 from the Police Forfeiture Funds account will provide the funding necessary to purchase the UTV and emergency equipment; and

WHEREAS, Treasure Island Police Chief Armand J.J. Boudreau has certified this purchase qualifies for the expenditure of contraband forfeiture funds.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF TREASURE ISLAND DOES RESOLVE THAT:

1. Staff is authorized to trade in existing equipment, to include; the 2002 Bombardier Quest 650 ATV, and the 2003 Gladiator Box Trailer, and purchase a 2016 Polaris Ranger 570 UTV from the GSA contract and outfit the vehicle in the amount of \$9,957.10.

2. The Commission approves a supplemental budget appropriation to accept and appropriate to the General Fund Police Department budget account 001-5210-64900:
 - a. a contribution of \$4,000 from the Treasure Island Police Association;
 - b. a previously made \$1,000 donation from the American Legion Post #158; and
3. Appropriate the amount of \$4957.10 from the unassigned fund balance of the Police Forfeiture Fund to account 138-5214-64900 for the purchase of the UTV with equipment installed.
4. This resolution is effective on adoption.

The foregoing Resolution was offered during Regular Session of the City Commission of the City of Treasure Island, Florida, sitting on the 4th day of October, 2016 by Commissioner Lunn who moved its adoption; was seconded by Commissioner Keys and upon roll call, the vote was:


