

14. Responsible for personal safety and safety of all field crew members under supervision.
15. Responsible for the maintenance and routine inspection of all equipment, tools and vehicles in the division.
16. Performs related work as required.

(These essential job functions are not to be construed as a complete statement of all duties performed. Employees will be required to perform other job related marginal duties as required.)

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS AND ABILITIES:

- Knowledge of modern techniques, methods, procedures and practices of providing and maintaining municipal infrastructure.
- Ability to establish and maintain effective working relationships with subordinates and the general public.
- Ability to frequently lift/move 25lbs. and occasionally lift/move 75lbs.
- Ability to walk, sit, climb, balance, stoop, kneel, crouch, crawl, see and smell.
- Ability to respond to after hours call-ins in a reasonable amount of time.
- Ability to comply with work schedules.
- Regularly required to use hands to feel, handle and operate controls and tools.
- Ability to make minor electrical and mechanical repairs to various types of motors, pumps and other related equipment.
- Ability to communicate well verbally and in writing, and must possess excellent people skills.

EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE:

Must possess a high school diploma or a GED.

Three (3) years' experience in the field of Public Works relating to the operation, maintenance and repair of pumps, motors and electrical panels in a wastewater/ storm water system.

(A comparable amount of training, education or experience may be substituted for the above minimum qualifications.)

LICENSES, CERTIFICATIONS OR REGISTRATIONS:

Valid Florida CDL B Driver's License.
Class C Wastewater License.
Storm water certificate.

ESSENTIAL PHYSICAL SKILLS:

- Acceptable eyesight (with or without corrections)
- Acceptable hearing (with or without aid)
- Ability to communicate both orally and in writing.
- Ability to lift more than 60 lbs. on a frequent basis.
- Ability to walk, sit, climb, balance, stoop, kneel, crouch, crawl, see and smell.

ENVIRONMENTAL CONDITIONS:

- Works both indoors and outside and will be exposed to outside weather elements.

(Reasonable accommodation will be made for otherwise qualified individuals with a disability.)
