The Treasure Island Police Department, in conjunction with the Pinellas County Sheriff's Office, have completed a long-term undercover narcotics investigation targeting drug sales occurring within the city limits of Treasure Island, FL.

This investigation began in late July 2014 and concluded on December 8, 2014 and utilized undercover detectives and informants.

A total of thirteen (13) subjects completed multiple drug sales to undercover personnel during this project. These sales included; crack cocaine, prescription drugs (pills), marijuana, powder cocaine, heroin, and synthetic cannabinoids.

A round up was conducted on December 8th in which five (5) of the subjects were arrested and transported to jail. Of those, two (2) had narcotics in their possession at the time of their arrest and additional charges were added. Eight (8) subjects remain at large and efforts continue to take them into custody.

This is the second long-term undercover narcotics project in recent years for the Treasure Island Police Department. Other investigations are in progress, and the department and City remains committed to investigate tips received and take aggressive action for any and all narcotics violations.
