Two candidates vie for TI mayor's office this year

January 20, 2015 – The two candidates for Treasure Island mayor will face off in a debate on Thursday evening, January 29th at Treasure Island City Hall, 120 108th Avenue. The debate begins at 6pm and is hosted by Treasure Island resident Larry Lunn, under the rules agreed to by the candidates and developed by Treasure Island Voter's Watch, who have hosted debates in Treasure Island since 2000.

The two candidates on the ballot for Treasure Island mayor March 10th are incumbent Mayor Bob Minning and Sunset Beach resident Mel Lenehan. This is the only race on all ballots this election cycle. There are no ballot questions this year.

Elections scheduled for commission Districts 1 and 3 this year were uncontested, meaning Phil Collins returns for a sixth two-year term as District 1 Commissioner, and District 3 Commissioner Carol Coward, who chose to retire this year after three terms, is replaced by Patrick Jeffares, who ran unopposed in District 3.

Costs of staging a typical election for all four Treasure Island precincts runs about \$12,000.

Swearing in of the 2015 Treasure Island City Commission is Tuesday, March 17, 2015 at 6pm.
