GULF BLVD. PAVING WILL TAKE 4 WEEKS

South of 105th gets paved first, then the north end

May 5, 2015 –Beginning May 11th the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will be milling and repaving the entire length of Gulf Boulevard in Treasure Island.

The milling and repaving portion of this project, originally scheduled for early March of this year, was postponed after just five days of work when Spring Break traffic, combined with regularly busy local traffic, caused long backups on Gulf Boulevard and city side streets.

Now that many winter visitors have left for the season, FDOT has decided to resume the Gulf Boulevard milling and repaving project on Monday, May 11th, 2015. The first section to be milled and paved is the stretch of roadway from 99th Avenue to 105th Avenue and it is expected to be finished by May 21st. After the Memorial Day holiday, Gulf Boulevard between 105th Avenue and 127th Avenue will be repaved. This schedule is subject to change due to weather conditions.

The milling and paving work will require both north and southbound lane closures on Gulf Boulevard. Lane closures will cause traffic delays, Monday thru Friday from May 11, 2015 through May 21st, 2015. Only one lane will be closed at a time in order to maintain reasonable traffic flow.

Work hours are from 8am to 8pm. Night and weekend work is not allowed.
